

HENRY SAYS (SIMON SAYS) GAME

Play this game of "Henry Says" with your parent or teacher and friends.

Setup: Select one person to play the role of Henry (the leader). Have the other players line up facing Henry.

Play: Similar to "Simon Says," Henry gives commands to the group by saying "Henry Says" and the children follow Henry's command. When the leader issues a command <u>not</u> prefaced by "Henry Says," the children should not follow the command. If they do, they are out of the game.

Henry Says:

Be true to who you are—stand up straight.

Be true to who you are—look at yourself in a mirror.

Be true to who you are—hug yourself.

Be true to who you are—smile.



Henry Says:

Hard things happen—take a deep breath.

Hard things happen—close your eyes.

Hard things happen – make a frown.

Hard things happen—scratch your head.

Henry Says:

Play the hand you are dealt—shake your hands.

Play the hand you are dealt—shake your head.

Play the hand you are dealt—shake your body.

Play the hand you are dealt—wiggle your toes.





Henry Says:

Connect with what you care about—shake hands with someone.

Connect with what you care about – give Henry a hug.

Connect with what you care about – hold hands and make a circle.

Connect with what you care about - hold hands and shout: "I care."

Henry Says:

Hate is learned—cover your ears.

Hate is learned—shut your eyes.

Hate is learned—close your mouth.

Hate is learned—face someone and say hello.












ANIMAL PUPPET SHOW



















HENRY AND FRIENDS FINGER PUPPETS
